

Safety Commitment Measure

Insight to safety commitment at all levels

Effective safety performance can only be achieved by the collective behaviours of workers who have the capacity and commitment to choose to act safely in their daily role. These decisions and actions can impact positively or negatively on your workers, their peers, supervisors and the overall workplace. The results can be anything from safe, productive and satisfying work through to accidents, litigation and death.

Beyond your workers' competence and skill levels, it is vital to consider the factors that may shape or influence their willingness to comply and perform proactive safe work behaviour.



The Safety Commitment Measure (SCM) is a new tool provided by the LGIS team to assist local governments in gaining a snap shot of the perceptions and commitment of all levels of workers and management on various aspects of safety in your workplace.

Establishing a baseline first can identify how your local government can further achieve an effective organisational safety culture through targeted interventions assisted by LGIS. Key features of this measure include:

- Assessment of safety values, safety recognition, safety leadership and active participation at all levels

- A targeted approach to the safety culture perceptions within various staff groups
- A full report and dashboard on findings, recommendations and interventions
- Follow up support to help you implement recommendations
